Situated on a private 1.91-acre double wooded lot, the property is bordered by Little Crowe Creek, where the distant sound of a picturesque waterfall creates a serene backdrop. A pathway near the property line leads to the creek and waterfall, enhancing the outdoor living experience. The spacious screened-in porch is the perfect spot to unwind, while the outdoor living spaces—including covered porches on both the main and terrace levels, a fire pit, and an above-ground swimming pool with endless opportunities for relaxation and entertainment. The pool was a special wish fulfilled for one of the family's three adopted daughters, adding a personal touch to the home's charm. 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
