On the mezzanine level, the primary bedroom suite showcases original structural beams combined with modern luxuries such as his-and-her vanities and a soaking tub enclosed in the bathroom's wet room. An open-air, cantilevered den serves as a perfect home office or secondary living area. Additionally, an expertly crafted office nook, unique to residence 302, was created from additional space found during construction. Completing the mezzanine level is a spacious laundry room outfitted with custom cabinetry. An owner's retreat or second bedroom, currently utilized as a well-appointed home gym, features a full array of fitness equipment and a custom wet bar. A private loggia adjacent to this space offers an open-air escape with exposed brick and soaring ceilings. Plans are available to convert this space into a bedroom suite with a full bathroom. The meticulous revitalization earned the esteemed Carolopolis Award from the Preservation Society of Charleston, honoring its architectural significance and enduring legacy.
